(Superseding and revising Resolution 1981-02)

RESOLUTION ADOPTING and REVISING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000, et.seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regulations Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code which can be incorporated by reference and may be amended after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act; and

WHEREAS, this body has determined that the attached Appendix accurately sets forth those positions which should be designated and the categories of financial interests which should be made reportable;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

1. The terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Appendix in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the conflict of interest code of the Diamond Springs/El Dorado Fire Protection Fire District.

2. Pursuant to Section 4(A) of the standard code, designated employees shall file statement of economic interest with the District. Upon receipt of the statements from the Board of Directors and the Chief, the District shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these statements to the El Dorado County Elections Department.
