

# Diamond Springs-El Dorado Fire Protection District Firefighter/EMT

## About the Department

The Diamond Springs-El Dorado Fire Protection District service area covers 65.5 square miles in the mideastern portion of El Dorado County. Our agency staffs an ALS Fire Engine 24/7 and cross-staffs a Truck and Medium Rescue that respond to all areas of El Dorado County. Calls for service average between 3,400-4,000 annually.

#### About the Position

This position is responsible for tasks associated with fire suppression, hazardous condition mitigation, emergency rescue, medical treatment, and pre/post emergency activities. This position works 24-hour shifts on a 48/96 schedule and as needed for emergency and staffing call back.

#### **Compensation and Benefits**

The salary range for the position of **Firefighter/EMT is \$62,522 - \$76,761 annually**. Additionally, the District provides a generous benefit package to include:

- CalPERS safety retirement: 3% @ 55 Classic with 9% employee contribution or 2.7% @ 57 PEPRA with 13.75% employee contribution
- CalPERS health benefits: district contribution \$1,171 \$3,043 monthly
- Dental, vision & hearing: district contribution \$120 \$200 monthly
- District paid life & long-term disability insurance
- 457 deferred compensation: district match up to 5%
- Accrued sick and vacation leave
- Holiday pay: 144 hours annually in lieu of 12 paid holidays
- Uniform allowance: \$1,000 annually
- Longevity pay: up to 5% based on years of service
- Educational incentives: up to 5%
- Education and training reimbursement: \$2,000 annually

## Minimum Requirements

- Must be active on the Firefighter Candidate Testing Center (FCTC) Statewide Eligibility List (SEL). Applicants must have a passing score on the FCTC Written Test and an FCTC Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) card within one year of the final application filing date of January 12, 2024. - High school diploma or equivalent

- Possess and maintain a California Class C driver's license. Possession of a Firefighter Endorsement must be obtained within twelve months of hire date and maintained throughout employment.
- Possess and maintain a current BLS/CPR card from American Heart or Red Cross Professional Level
- Possess and maintain a current State of California Emergency Medical Technician 1 certification
- Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations certificate
- ICS 200 certificate

## Additional Requirements

- CSFM Rescue Systems 1 or equivalent completed within twelve months of hire date
- CSFM Certified Firefighter I completed within twelve months of hire date
- Firefighter Type 1 (FFT1) qualified per CICCS guidelines within twelve months of hire date
- Candidates considered for employment must successfully complete a background check, physical exam, drug screen, live scan fingerprinting, and driving history review.
